

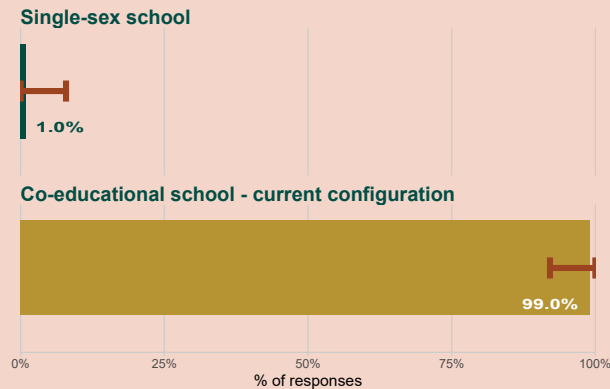

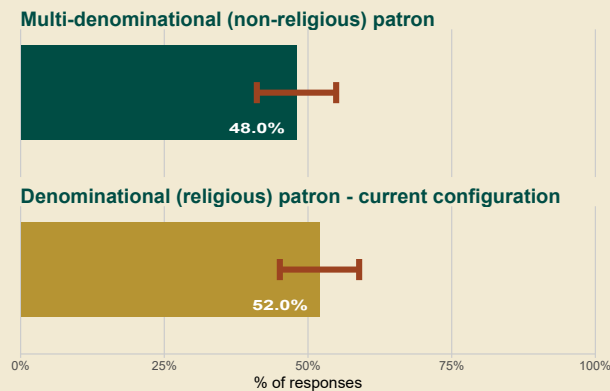

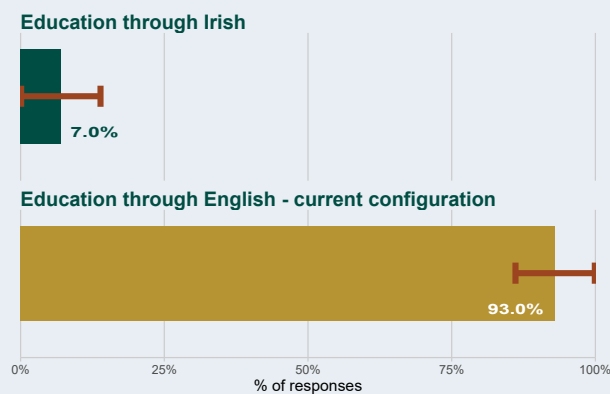
Co-educational / single-sex preference

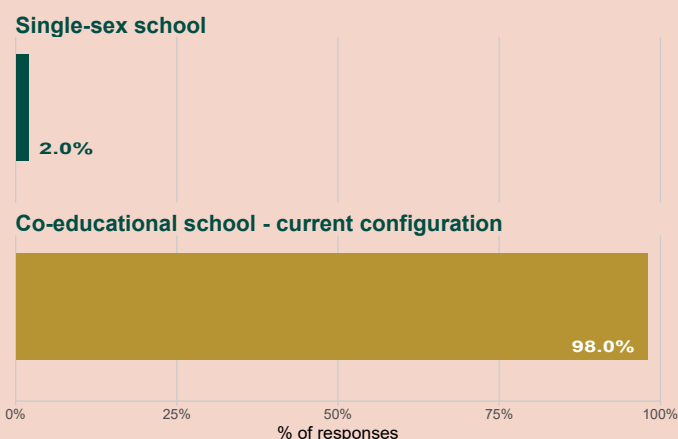

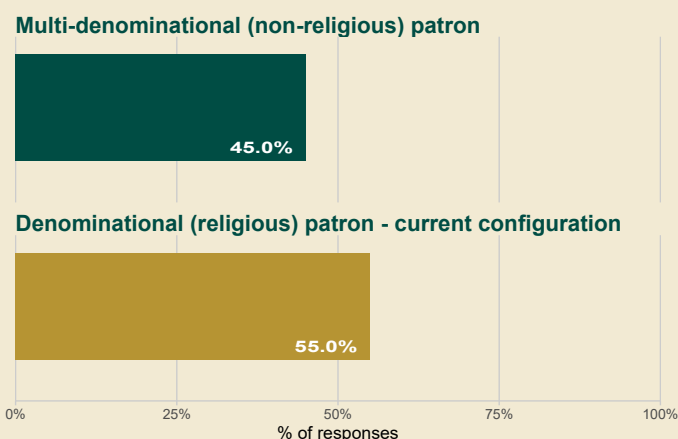

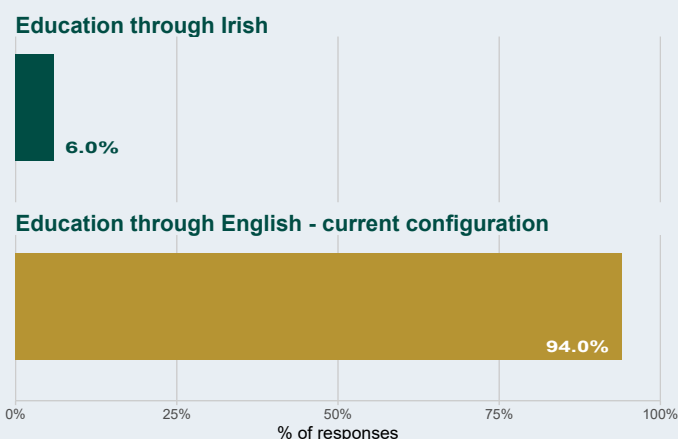
